The theme of the seminar is not only a problem for the students but also a big challenge for the teachers as well as institution due to new course to deal up. Then the meeting then winded up.

The technical session started at 12. Noon for the presentation of the students. The resource person Mr. Hem Kanta Phukan, retired associated professor of D.R. College has been invited on the dais and along with the invited judge Mrs. Dipa Phukan Baruah and they were felicitates with phulam Gamushas. Mr. Phukan was addressed to say few words on the event. He very briefly said about why seminar is organize, how to follow the rules of a seminar and to present. He added that seminar is a discussion among some group of people for a problem to find a solution. And evaluation is also much important for a seminar. Then the student's presentation started by-

Tinku Saikia, B.A. 2nd Semester, Dept of Political Science, Marangi Mahavidyalaya, the first presenter of the seminar. His study topic is - "Ekkok hakhar mahavidyalayot CBCS ". He mentioned about the problems and issues regarding CBCS course and in the rural area college students face problems for the course structures as maximum student background

livelihood is based on daily wages. After the presentation, one of the student ask question to Tinku Saikia - Whether poverty is stagnating for higher education? Tinku replied - Yes, to some extent. Because maximum students of the rural colleges are economically poor. First priority gives to livelihood then next comes for education.

Second participation is Jennifer Ali Begum, D.R College, Dept of English, B.A. 6th Semester. Her study topic: "Problems and Prospects of CBCS in undergraduate level". According to her CBCS course is not benefitted to rural area colleges. And it is due to poor economic condition. She added for choosing subjects according to will of students but the opportunity cannot be meet due to lack of three streams in one college especially under Golaghat district. At the question interaction she has been asked by a participant that whether she is happy with the system or not? Jennifer replied - No, because equal education is needed for all- rural and urban colleges.

Digvijay Handique, B.Sc. 4th Semester, Dept of Physics, C.N.B College is the 3rd presenter. Topic: Problems and Prospects of CBCS in the under graduate level. He mentioned that C.N.B College has only one stream that is Science stream situated at Bokakhat. By having one stream in the college, the students are deprived of the opportunities to choose other stream subjects under CBCS course. He has been questioned by Jennifer Begum and answered by Digvijay.

Next Jubin Kurmi and Rishov Borah, Joya Gogoi College, Khumtai was B.A. 4th presenter. Topic: Choice Based Credit System in undergraduate level and rural college under Dibrugarh University. They both present the paper properly putting their views on the advantages and disadvantages of CBCS course. In the question interaction session, no question arises for them.

Mow Mazumdar, B.A. 5th Semester, Dept of Political Science, Marangi Mahavidyalaya was the 5th paper presenter. Topic: CBCS in Rural Colleges. She shows on transportation problems for students though the course fee is free from government as maximum students are from farmer background. Minimum fund is release for rural area colleges rather than urban area college. Vacancies of teachers found in rural colleges. In the question interaction a participant ask question to put a suggestion for the problem she showed in the paper. She replied by - both

No. 6th presenter was Bishal Mahanta, B.A. 2nd Semester, Deptt of Political Science, Barpothar College. **Topic-“Isnatok Parjayor Pasandvitiik Maan Byabosthya Pathyokrom Homosya Aru Homvawona”**. He discussed about online and digital system of CBCS course that faced as challenges by rural area colleges. Lack of smart classes, audio visual classes, etc is deprived by rural area students. No question arises.

No. 7th presenter was Tridip Barman, B.A. 4th Semester, D.R.College. **Topic – “Aantogathoni Aru CBCS Byabostha”** His paper analysed about grading and learning of CBCS course. He also added that teachers are lying vacant especially in rural area colleges up to 35% which become big problem for a college to run and to complete the course in the set period. One question asked by participant to put suggestion on the problem. Tridip answered that full co-operation of Government is needed as well as awareness about the system.

Madhurika Saikia, B.A. 2nd Semester, Deptt of English, H.P.B. Girls College was the no. 8th presenter. **“Topic- Undergraduate Curriculum in CBCS.”** She discussed about problems or bars, and advantages of arts and Humanities in CBCS. Also shows the prospects of curriculum under CBCS in near future. No question arises.

Himashri Bora, B.A 6th Semester, Deptt of Economics, Furkating College was the 9th presenter. **Topic- CBCSor Rupayonor Khetrot Gramya Mahavidyalayor Isnatok Hikhyarthir Dristivonggi.”** She mentioned that to bringing up equal education system in comparing to other state or national education system CBCS course is very essential. From C.N.B College and Jaya Gogoi college professors delivered their view point and thanks giving speech. Lastly the college principal (President of the meeting) gave vote of thanks by putting his words – thanks to organizer committee and ACTA Golaghat Zone for such a successful event, and to organize more seminars, workshops and other competitive events frequently in the college or to interact with other colleges for upbringing development of students. 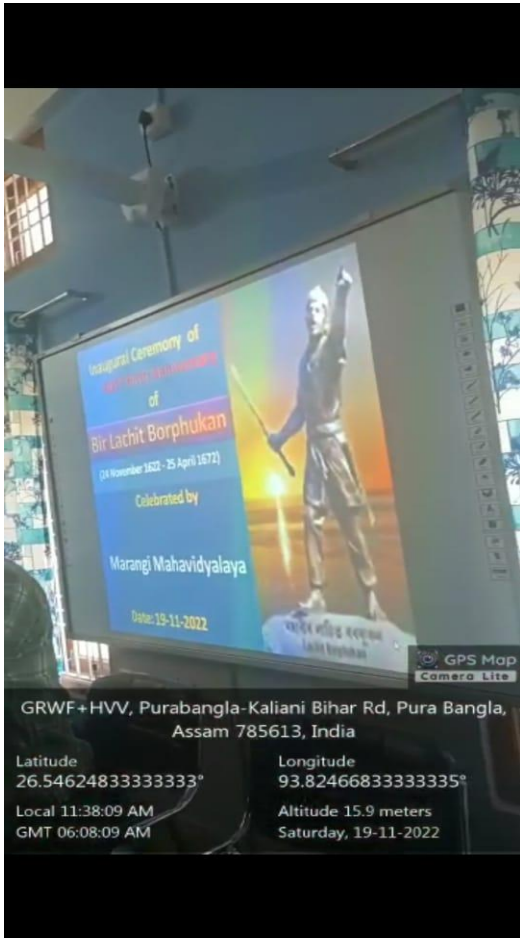

Barphuka was the title given to the commander-in-chief of the Ahom Army. His birth anniversary is celebrated as Lachit Divas in Assam. He was ~~an~~ an inspiration to millions of people and tales of his courage ~~will be~~ ~~for~~ told till generations. The battle of Saraighat in 1671 was of great importance. It was fought between the Mughals and

the Ahoms. The Mughal Army was led by Ram Singh and the Ahom army was under the Lachit Barphukan. Lachit was extremely serious and was ~~on~~ ~~sickbed~~ sickbed at the time of the battle of Saraighat. Still, he told his soldiers to carry his bed to the battle field and took control of his army. He ~~for~~ fought a naval battle with the Mughal Army on the mighty Brahmaputra. One of the incidents that happened during the battle was that his maternal uncle was in-charge of a bridge construction and when Lachit went ~~is~~ for inspection he found that the people were sleeping and the work was incomplete. He got angry and ~~cut~~ severed his uncle's throat saying the famous slogan, 'Country is

biggest of more importance than my uncle'. All the soldiers and people wake up and completed the work that very night.

The history of Assam ~~will~~ ~~be~~ ~~of~~ ~~great~~ ~~importance~~. The Lachit Barphukan is of an immense personality in the history of Assam. His act of bravery and fearlessness will always be remembered. He is an inspiration to millions of youths who want to serve the country.
