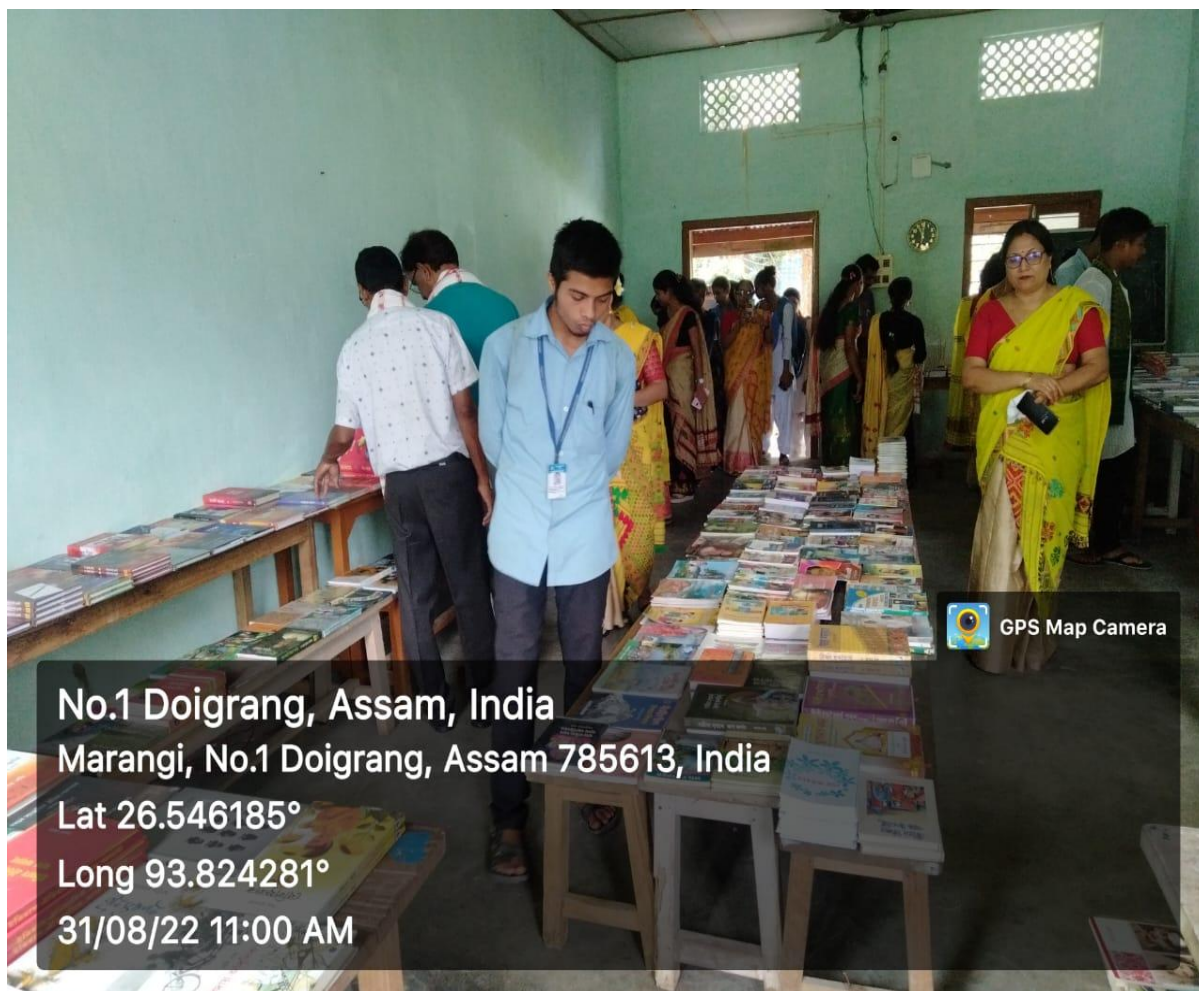
Introduction:
