The 2021 Munin Barkatki Literature Award for Chaki and Other Stories to Pradyumna Kumar Gogoi

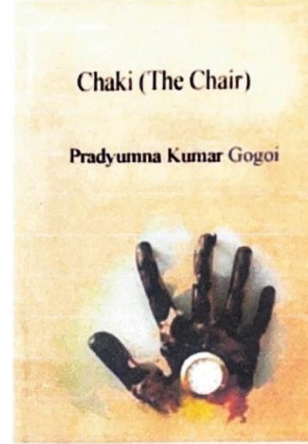

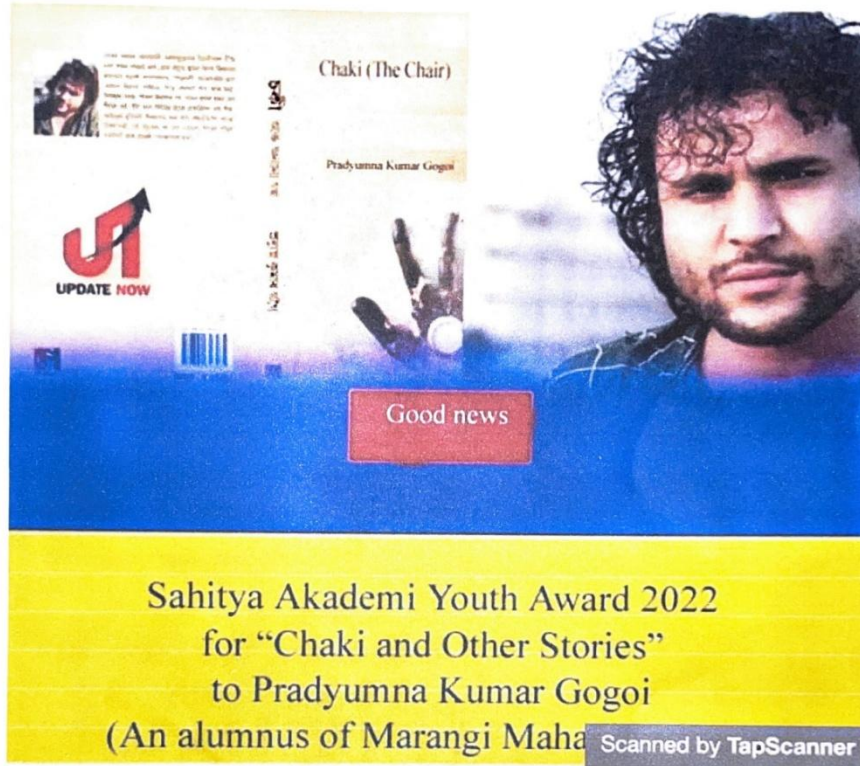
